THE REQUEST

 primary leadership roles.
- There were two new team members (both on board less than 2 months.) **Use this event to** have them bond and build relationships with the team.
- · Use this event to further existing relationships.
- Conduct an "as real as we can make it" event that forces employees to work as a team and make sound rapid decisions in an interactive, dynamic, and tactical environment.
